

## POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

The rules and regulations set forth below were developed to ensure the safety and pleasure of all members of the Saratoga Community Recreation Association Pool. Feel free to report any violations to the lifeguards on duty, or contact any member of the Saratoga Community Recreation Association (“SCRA”) Board of Directors. (Numbers are available at the lifeguard station.)

1. Membership cards will be given to each individual family member. Members must sign in at the front gate and show cards. (There is a \$5 fee to replace lost cards.)
2. Pool guest passes may be purchased for \$5.00 per day, per person. Children under the age of 3 are free. All guests, including out-of-town parents and grandparents, MUST pay.
3. Guests must be accompanied by a member and sign in at the front gate area. If the member leaves the pool, the guest must also leave at that time. Members will be held responsible for their guests' behavior or lack thereof.
4. Only one person at a time on the diving board allowed. After diving, the person must immediately swim to the side. There should be no playing around or on the diving board at any time.
5. No floatation devices are allowed on diving board.
6. No rafts allowed in deep end of pool.
7. Children under the age of 13 are not allowed at the pool without adult supervision.
8. Rough housing, such as chicken fights, dunking, wrestling, towel flipping or soaked tennis balls, is not permitted.
9. The wading pool is for children 5 years and under.
10. No swimming in Bermudas, blue jeans, or other non-swimming attire is permitted.
11. SCRA is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
12. Loud music is prohibited.
13. Pool rentals will be scheduled from 9:00 p.m. to 12 midnight, provided a sufficient number of lifeguards are available to supervise the event. Pool rental is based on availability and requires a 14-day notice.

14. Reserving chairs is not permitted if the person is not present at the pool.
15. All children four (4) years and younger must wear a swim diaper.
16. The pool will close and the pool deck vacated when thunder is heard, lightning is present, and/or when it is definitively recognized that a thunderstorm is approaching. The pool will reopen 30 minutes past the last site of lightening or the last roll of thunder. In cases where severe thunderstorms have caused excess limbs, leaves, and/or debris to fall onto the deck and/or in the pool, the pool will be closed until such time as all debris have been sufficiently removed. No persons allowed in the pool area while cleanup is in progress.
17. Glass not allowed on the pool deck (fenced area).
18. No one is allowed in the pool or pool deck at any time without a lifeguard on duty.
19. These rules are subject to change.

**Violation of Rules 17 and 18, above, will be considered a serious violation potentially endangering the member or other members and is subject to a \$100 fine and/or loss of pool membership (without refund) on the first offense.**
